Chiroptera All families except Desmodontidae	Bats, flying foxes
Dermoptera	Flying lemurs
Edentata	Anteaters, sloths, armadillos
Hyracoidea	Hyraxes
Insectivora	Solenodons, tenrecs, otter shrews, golden moles, hedgehogs, elephant shrews, shrews, moles, desmans
Lagomorpha	Pikas, rabbits, hares
Marsupialia	Opossums, marsupial mice, dasyures, marsupial moles, marsupial anteaters, bandicoots, rat opossums, cuscuses, phalangers, koalas, wombats, wallabies, kangaroos
Primates All families except Hominidae (Man)	Tree-shrews, lemurs, indrises, sifakas, aye-aye, lorises, bush babies, tarsiers, titis, uakaris, sakis, howlers, capuchins, squirrel monkeys, marmosets, tamarins, macaques, mangabeys, baboons, langurs, gibbons, great apes
Rodentia	Gophers, squirrels, chipmunks, marmots, scaly-tailed squirrels, pocket mice, kangaroo-rats, beavers, mountain beavers, spring, beavers, spring haas, mice, rats, hamsters, lemmings, voles, gerbils, water rats, dormice, jumping mice, jerboas, porcupines, cavies (including guinea-pigs), capybaras, chinchillas, spiny rats, gundis
